Music Therapy with Orff-Schulwerk

Duration: 2 Days -6 hours

Target Group: Special education teachers, music therapists, music teachers, elementary school and preschool teachers, academicians, graduates and students of fine arts and education faculties, all educators working with children with special needs and interested in music therapy.

Instructor: Shirley Salmon, MPhil., PGCE, BA

Studied music, trained as a kindergarten and primary school teacher and studied educational science. She has worked for over 40 years as a music and movement teacher with children, young people and adults with different abilities and disabilities in extracurricular and school institutions and contexts, in formal and informal settings especially in inclusive groups. She was a lecturer at the Orff Institute of the Mozarteum University Salzburg from 1984 – 2019 in the area 'Music and Dance in Social Work and Inclusive Pedagogy' and she taught music and rhythmics at the teacher training universities in Graz, Austria from 2000 – 2015. She gives lectures, workshops and courses in Austria and internationally and has published books, a DVD and numerous articles.

Content:

Children with disabilities and special needs have a right to make music.

In this course you will see the principles and characteristics of Orff-Schulwerk and why these are so relevant to children with disabilities. And learn how a topic or song can be planned and developed to include many types of activities that allow and encourage play, improvisation and creativity at different levels of ability. You will be also looking at the importance and the types of differentiation. Video examples to illustrate the topics will be presented.

Instructor: Ksenija Burić, Ass.. Prof. Dr.

A passionate Music Therapist and Music Teacher with a diverse background in clinical practice and education. Sharing knowledge and experience with her students and all the course participants in the field of evidence-based music therapy interventions. Dedicated and compassionate Music Therapist with 30 years of experience in providing individualized and group music therapy interventions to address clients' emotional, cognitive and physical needs. The founder, music teacher and music therapist at *Schola Musica*, a private elementary music school and private clinical practice in music therapy. Currently she is working at the Catholic University of Croatia, Department of Psychology in Zagreb and I am a president of Croatian Orff Schulwerk Association, and the country representative to the European Music Therapy Confederation EMTC.

Content:

In this course you will see three topics of What Music Therapy (MT) is, Procedure in MT and A Research in MT. You are going to see the basic statements, theoretical background, some improvisational models and benefit from the MT treatment. The describing procedure in MT starting from the assessment session and all the process that is needed to be done to support the client with the best possible strategy, working on their own strong side. Additionally, details of a 2-year experimental study will be presented.
